



Program Description

The RN to B.S. in Nursing program is an innovative way for registered nurses (RNs) to achieve their goal of becoming baccalaureate prepared. The program features a hybrid approach to upper-division education where students experience both face-to-face and online offerings.

Students will build upon essential nursing skills such as leadership, professionalism, collaborative care, and quality care while also learning about themselves as they work to become more emotionally intelligent providers.

Admission Requirements

- x Hold an unencumbered Registered Nursing license and current registration in the state where clinical completion request lies
- x Associate degree or diploma degree in nursing from a registered and accredited nursing program in NYS, or nationally accredited by ACEN or NLNCNEA
- x Practiced nursing within the last 5 years or graduated from an associate degree or diploma nursing program within the last 5 years
