they simply summarize information source by source rather than gathering similar ideas together and showing relationships between them. If you simply summarize information


details back out to a place where they can see the whole topic.

5. Writing the Conclusion (see pages 3-4 for Annotated Example)

You should conclude (approximately 3/4 to 1 page) by reminding readers of the main topics and subtopics by identifying points of consensus and debate that have been presented in your literature review. Identify new possibilities for knowledge making, new gaps in knowledge what else could be looked at now that scholars know this information? Are there other contexts that need to be examined? Gaps in the research so far? You also want to include statements about what communities are best served by this knowledge where and for whom is the information most relevant?

6. Citing Your Sources

While you will be citing all through your literature review, do not forget that you also need to include a References page, Bibliography, or Works Cited page, depending on the citation style required for your literature review.



Annotated Example, cont'd

Due to the many different sub addictions this review will first look at general definitions of addiction and internet addiction and discuss prevalence and usage rates. Secondly, it will discuss

internet addict, predictive criteria that could be used in the diagnosis and prevention, negative impacts of internet addiction, assessment tools, and the treatment and prevention options available. Lastly, it will outline the five main sub-addictions of internet addiction and discuss the above topics in relation to them.

These definitions and criteria are not accepted by all researchers in the field. Other researchers believe that internet addiction falls under the category of impulse control disorders as outlined in the *Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders IV* (Ross, 2000; Whang, Lee, & Chang, 2003)

Johansson and Götestam (2004) equate internet addiction to gambling addiction as both involve maladaptive behavior patterns, tolerance, withdrawal, increasing use, unsuccessful efforts to eat down, and continued usage deepite problems. An abundance of research has looked at the prevalence rates of internet addiction.

This comprehensive review of the interature has outlined the definitions of various internet addictions, and has discussed motivating factors, profiles, predictors, negative impacts,
