Undergraduate Student Research Award (USRA) NSERC 2023

Applications for the [NSERC Undergraduate Student Research Awards](#) (USRA) for the 2023-2024 academic year will be accepted until March 17, 2023. These awards provide science students with funds to work for 16 weeks on supervised research projects. The amount of the NSERC USRA is \$6000 and must be supplemented by supervisor's external grant funding to meet the BC minimum wage rate for the 16-week project.
