A student's undergraduate grade point average determines his or her academic standing at the university and conditions associated with that status, including the ability to continue as an undergraduate student at UFV. Students must maintain an undergraduate CGPA of at least 2.00 to remain enrolled and in good academic standing at UFV.

Failure to meet the minimum CGPA requirements will result in restrictions on registration and may eventually lead to a student being withdrawn from the university. Academic standing will be

- 1. The first time a student is required to withdraw he or she is not eligible to attend for the following two semesters.
- 2. A student who is required to withdraw a second time is not eligible to attend for four semesters.
- 3. A student who is required to withdraw a third time will be considered for readmission only upon appeal after a minimum of three years.

During the withdrawal period, students may be permitted to
